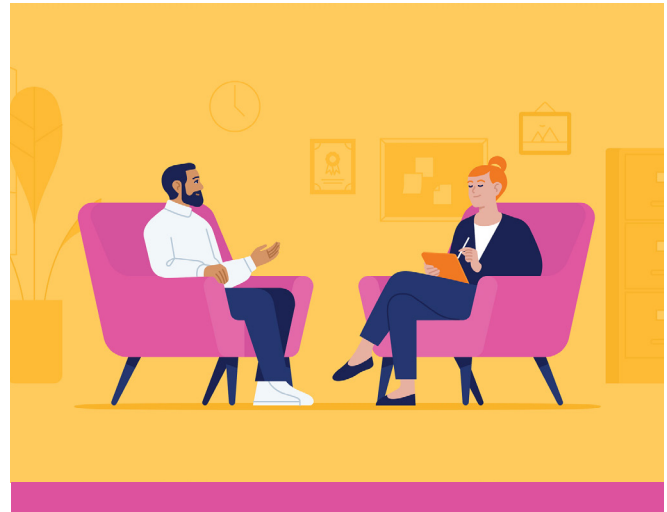
Patient's experience with a Genetic Counselor will include:

1. Schedule
2. Prepare and gather information for visit
3. Genetic Counseling visit
4. Genetic testing
5. Results review
6. Coordinating follow-up and next steps

What to Expect at Your Genetic Counseling Appointment?

The Genetic Counselor will:

1. Gather medical and family history, and identify testing options
2. Review possible genetic testing results
3. Review purpose, benefits, limitations, and risks to genetic testing including GINA
4. Support and assist with decision making. Genetic testing is always optional!



Common Indications

- Diabetes, Hyperglycemia or M.O.D.Y.
- Early Onset Obesity
- Hypogonadotropic hypogonadism
- Tuberous Sclerosis
- Congenital Adrenal Hyperplasia (CAH)
- Seizures or Epilepsy
- Primary Ciliary Dyskinesia (PCD)
- Hearing Loss or Deafness
- Hypertension or High Blood Pressure
- Kidney Disease, including: Polycystic Kidney Disease, Cystic Dysplastic Kidneys, Proteinuria, Hematuria
- Osteogenesis Imperfecta or Multiple Fractures
