

## SLEEP DISORDERED BREATHING CLINICAL TRIALS

<b>Obstructive Sleep Apnea in Interstitial Lung Disease TRIAL</b>	
<b>Official Title:</b> A prospective study of the prevalence of sleep disordered breathing in interstitial lung disease	
Purpose	To identify the prevalence of obstructive sleep apnea in an outpatient population of ILD patients
Select Inclusion Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Must be 18 years old at the time of informed consent.</li><li>2. Must have an ILD diagnosis.<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Those with IPF must be diagnosed according to the ATS/ERS consensus statement, with or without surgical lung biopsy prior to the Screening visit.</li></ol></li><li>3. Must be clinically stable, as determined by the investigator, and able to tolerate an overnight polysomnography.</li><li>4. Subjects who are currently diagnosed with OSA and are on treatment may participate in this study.</li></ol>
