All members of Northern Virginia’s culturally diverse communities are welcome at Inova Cares Clinic for Families (ICCF). We are now offering FREE flu vaccines for uninsured people, while supplies last. A yearly vaccine is the best way to prevent the flu. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that adults and children age 6 months and older get an annual flu shot. Our team members will abide by all current CDC and [Safe@Inova](#) guidelines.
