Eligibility

- Be under age 21
- Have a diagnosed medical condition or physical disorder that is expected to last 12 months or longer
- Live in one of these areas:
 - **County of:** Arlington, Fairfax, Loudoun, Prince William, Spotsylvania or Stafford
 - **City of:** Alexandria, Fairfax, Falls Church, Fredericksburg, Manassas City or Manassas Park
