Nurse Practitioners, and Physician Assistants applying for credentials for Moderate Sedation must meet:

- a. Review of Inova Sedation Policy with successful score on the Inova Sedation Exam. In addition, providers requesting Pediatric sedation privileges must successfully complete the Inova Pediatric Sedation Exam. Providers performing sedation on children less than 6 are required to obtain specific credentialing in pediatric sedation.
- b. Written approval of Department Chairman

<u>AND</u>

Current ACLS, ATLS, PALS or NRP, as is appropriate for the provider's specialty

AND

One of the following:

- Documentation of twelve (12) successful and uncomplicated Moderate or Deep Sedation procedures or airway interventions in adult and/or pediatric patients in the past two years. For initial appointments only, if documentation of cases are not available, an attestation of competency from the prior department chair is acceptable.
- Completion of sedation course approved by American Society of Anesthesiologists (ASA) or American College of Emergency Physicians (ACEP) in the past 2 years.
- Completion of a nationally recognized advanced airway course in the past 2 years.
- Participation in an Inova Endorsed Airway Simulation or Sedation course in the past 2 years.

Verification of Privileges:

Log on to InovaNet to verify whether or not provider is credentialed to perform Moderate Sedation. InovaNet > Physician Directory>Type in Providers Name> Click on Operating Unit where procedure is being performed, type in providers name to verify delineation of privileges
