Purpose:

Define the guidelines for pharmacy resident licensure.

Applies to:

All pharmacy residents within the Inova Health System (IHS). This applies to both Post Graduate Year 1 and 2 (PGY1&2).

Definitions:

Licensure – Virginia Board of Pharmacy license to practice as a pharmacist.

Policy Description:

- All residents are expected to have an active pharmacy license in the State of Virginia by July 1 of the start of the residency year

- 3. Failure to obtain pharmacist licensure:
 - a. In the event that a resident is not licensed by July 1, a meeting will be set up between the resident, the Residency Program Director (RPD) and the Director of Pharmacy
 - b. The reasons for failure to obtain licensure will be reviewed and the residents status in the program will be evaluated
 - c. The resident will be required to make up any weekend and weekday staffing shifts that are missed due to lack of licensure
 - d. Failure to obtain licensure by September 1st will result in termination from the program
