The student will participate in all clinical activities including direct patient medical care, as well as ward-rounds and team conferences. They will be exposed to the inter-disciplinary team approach to PM&R management from other disciplines, including: therapies (PT, OT, Speech), Nursing, Case Management and Social Work.
