

## Hospital-based Clinical Documentation Specialists Support ICD-10

Clinical Documentation Specialists (CDS) are now available at each Inova hospital Monday through Friday during day shift. The CDS are RNs and MDs who are fully trained in ICD-10. They review inpatient records concurrently and submit queries on specific documentation issues that affect profiling of your expected mortality, length of stay and complications. Starting in September, CDS will also post queries to support ICD-10 coding for quality outcomes.

These on-site specialists are part of an overall ICD-10 training and education program that includes online and interactive, hospital-based training by specialty. **Dr. Zviad Ksovreli** leads the CDS; he is also part of the Systemwide physician training team that will conduct ICD-10 specialty-based training at each hospital. Scheduled trainings will be posted on the <a href="Physician Documentation">Physician Documentation</a> page of InovaNet and announced in the <a href="Physician Brief">Physician Brief</a> newsletters.
