Visitation Policy Changes Effective June 1, 2022

Masking

Masks will still be required for all visitors in all areas at all times.



Visitor Hours: 8 a.m. – 11 p.m.

Exceptions include:

Labor and Delivery: open 24/7 for visitation Pediatric Units: open 24/7 for visitation. Parents or caregivers only Post-Partum Units: open to visitors from 9 a.m. – 9 p.m.



Minimum Age: 12 years old

All minors must be accompanied by an adult (for pediatrics that adult must be a parent or caregiver) at all times. For Pediatric Intensive Care Units, only parents or caregivers are allowed.



Number of Visitors at a Time:

Hospitalized patients and Emergency Department: Two (2) visitors Labor and Delivery: Two (2) visitors (cannot switch individuals) + Doula Outpatient and procedural areas: One (1) companion



Overnight Visitation

Overnight visitation is allowed for all patients in a private room; one (1) person for adult patients or two (2) parents/guardians for minors (care teams may use discretion if an additional care provider is necessary for the visit).



Exceptions

Exceptions can also be made in end-of-life situations and at the team's discretion if an additional care provider is necessary for the visit.
